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DR. MICHAEL HYSON

9 DR. HYSON: Go? Okay. Well, thank you for
10 letting me speak here. I hope my input can have some
11 value.

12 Star Newland and I, through the Sirius Institute
13 and Planet Puna, have been studying mostly the effects of
14 birth and general birth and water birth on the constitution
15 of humans. And one of the major experts in underwater
16 birth and birth in general is a French medical doctor named
17 Dr. Michel Odent. And he points out that nearly all
18 cultures have messed around with the birth imprint or the
19 birthing process. For example, some cultures will express
20 the mother's colostrum and throw it away to make sure that
21 the baby never has it in spite of the fact it's the most
22 helpful thing it could get right at birth. Other cultures
23 would put sand, salt, bread, sugar, rice, anything other
24 than milk as the first taste for an infant.

25 So we have planet-wide messed up the process of
1 birth. Recently -- well, not recently but over the last
2 decades, they've been using more and more synthetic
3 Oxytocin, Pitocin, and it's causing great fetal distress,
4 but it also messes up the bonding and the suckling between
5 the mother and infant. So we are rapidly losing the
6 ability to give birth properly.

7 The punchline of this is when you do this to an
8 infant, since the type of life they have is dependent on
9 their birth imprint, you end up -- if you interfere with
10 birth in a major way like we've been doing, you end up with
11 people that have missed connecting with their mothers, with
12 the Earth, and they are great warriors, and they are
13 traumatized. They're enraged, and they're ready to kill at
14 some point because we have messed up their birth imprint.

15 So we have fallen into this, and that might be
16 one of the major reasons why we have such a warlike planet.
17 So fortunately the Navy has agreed to partner with Star
18 Newland and the Sirius Institute for domestic harmony, and
19 so we're here to talk to them about that. And we hope that
20 the Navy can start this process that one could imagine, for
21 example, Navy wives giving birth in the water with the
22 service dolphins that the Navy already has. One can
23 imagine the service dolphins helping the returning veterans
24 with their traumas and post-traumatic stress disorders and
25 so on. And this could lead to a much more harmonious
1 planet, which is consonant with the Navy goals right now,
2 that they will pursue humanitarian efforts to avoid or
3 reduce conflict before they will choose to attack and to do
4 other things like that.

5 So we're very proud that the Navy wants to do
6 that, and we're hoping they'll continue, and we're here to
7 help in any way to reverse this trend on the planet.
