

16 MR. KALEIWAHEA: I hope that you guys understand
17 in the three minutes that I have because one reason I'll be
18 (inaudible). I want to ask you a question to you, you
19 people. Do you know what Hawaii is here in the
20 contribution to the world? Do you know what Hawaii is?

23 MR. KALEIWAHEA: Because you guys have to have
24 an understanding that what we're here as a contributor to
25 the world. We represent the heart in the (inaudible)
1 system of humanity. This is why we have a culture Kanaloa.
2 And for what you guys are doing, it's, you know, a
3 beautiful culture that we have. You know, you guys are
4 destroying it on the land, the water. You know, you guys
5 not thinking. Why we're here, the way our (inaudible) put
6 us here in this master plan because we have a culture. You
7 guys don't. You guys are manmade culture. Ours organic.
8 And this is why you guys got to know what we represent in
9 this world by the system of humanity.

10 We represent the heart, brah. This is why we
11 (inaudible). And because you no can understand that
12 (inaudible), you know, how we going to pull this world
13 together? You got to understand. You see that mountain up
14 there? That's the (inaudible), the gods. Okay?
15 (Inaudible) has three sides that connect the four pillars
16 of the world. You understand me? Four pillars of the
17 world: north, south, east, west. Okay? You people come
18 to the west, go in there. You represent (inaudible). Go
19 into the east (inaudible).

20 We come from Kanaloa, the living spirit over the
21 land and the water, and we come from a culture Kanaloa.
22 You guys have to make that connection so we can pull the
23 world together. I'm not (inaudible). America, Japan,
24 China (inaudible). Okay? Why? Because this reason:

25 They're supposed to come here and understand. (Inaudible.)

1 It's a power play, one with the (inaudible) and one with
2 military gain. That's not the way, man. We got to pull
3 the world together. The world is the heart, and that's
4 what we're here for. Okay?
